## Support for Comprehensive Exercise planned by the National Government

- The organization perform planning, support and evaluation for pre-exercise, and we prepare the progress plan and the exercise procedure for comprehensive nuclear emergency exercise that the national government, local government, and license holders jointly conducted once a year. The organization also takes part in this comprehensive exercise. Moreover, we compile the records of exercise to improve the future exercise and analyze the problem to reflect it to the future exercise planning.

## Support for Nuclear Emergency Exercise Planned by each Local Governments

- The Organization supplies the information such as accident situation and prediction of accident progression to nuclear emergency exercise planned by local government independently, according to the progress of the exercise. The organization supports for operation of facilities in the Offsite Center.

  - [Exercise stage]
    - (1) Participation in exercise Management of the exercise Operation of ERSS and facilities
  - [Evaluation stage]
    - (1) Three kinds of evaluation, which are Questionnaires to the participants Assessment by third party Opinion of specialists were performed to reflect to the future exercise.
